PETITION FOR AWARD OF SECOND INTERIM ATTORNEY'S FEES AND COSTS TO ALLEN NORTON & BLUE, P.A. AS COUNSEL TO THE RECEIVER AND MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

(June 19, 2004 – September 30, 2004)

Pursuant to Court Order, all objections to this Application must be filed and served within (10) days of this Application.

Rodolfo Gomez, a Shareholder of Allen Norton & Blue, (AN& B) hereby requests this Court to enter an order authorizing the Receiver to pay the reasonable attorney's fees and costs incurred by AN&B as labor and employment attorneys to the Receiver, Roberto

Martínez (the Receiver), and in support of this application, the undersigned submits the following:

- 1. Attached as **Exhibit 1** is a summary of AN &B's fees and expenses incurred through September 30, 2004 (the Application Period). **Exhibit 2** is a summary of all AN&B timekeepers, their billing rates and the total hours that were charged by each timekeeper in their representation of the Receiver during the Application Period.
- 2. Attached as **Exhibit** 3 is a summary of all expenses incurred by AN&B during the Application period.
- 3. The Receiver hired AN & B to advise him on the appropriate treatment of employees in a Receivership situation. AN & B has advised the Receiver and his counsel regarding several issues relating to the employment of the over 100 employees working at the Receivership Entities, including issues relating to employee termination, treatment of independent agents, COBRA benefits, 401 K plan and health benefits.
- 4. For the Application Period, AN&B seeks reimbursement for 6.70 hours of attorney time. The total amount of fees sought during the application period is \$ 1,762.50. Total expenses sought by AN &B for the application period are \$ 262.39.
- 5. I have carefully reviewed the attached exhibits and I am responsible for supervising all of the attorneys in my firm on the case. I certify that the hours expended

AN&B maintains detailed time records that are kept contemporaneously with the services performed. Within 10 days, AN&B will file these detailed records under seal to the Court for review *in camera*.

and the costs incurred were necessary and reasonable to represent the Receiver during the Application Period.

MEMORANDUM OF LAW

When determining the award of attorneys fees, the Court should give consideration to the factors for compensation that the 11th Circuit articulated in InreNormanv. Housing Authority of City of Montgomery, 836 F.2d 1292 (11th Cir. 1988) - (1) the time and labor properly employed by the attorneys in processing the case; (2) the quality of services rendered; (3) the scope of the activity and conspiracy under attack; (4) the financial risk involved; (5) the magnitude, complexity and novelty of the issues involved; (6) the beneficial results obtained; and (%) the degree to which, if any, effort were supported by prior governmental action. AN&B respectfully suggests that its application meets all of the criteria for this interim request for compensation. The Receiver, with the assistance of AN&B, has stabilized operations, and effectively dealt with labor and employment issues and, to the extent possible, maintained the status quo, with respect to employee compensation and benefits.

WHEREFORE, ALLEN, NORTON & BLUE, P.A., by and through the undersigned counsel, respectfully requests that this Court enter an Order Authorizing the Payment of \$1,762.50. in fees and reimbursement of \$262.39 in costs for the Application Period. A proposed form of Order is attached.

In total, the Petition seeks approval of the payment of \$2,024.02 consisting of \$1,762.50 in fees and \$262,38 in costs.

Petition for Fees and Costs is hereby GRANTED and Receiver, Roberto Martínez is hereby
