RECEIVER'S MOTION FOR AUTHORIZATION TO ENTER INTO SETTLEMENT AGREEMENTS WITH MBC SALES AGENTS

Roberto Martínez, Esq., as Court-appointed Receiver of Mutual Benefits Corp. ("MBC"); Viatical Benefactors, LLC ("VBLLC"); Viatical Services, Inc. ("VSI"); and Anthony Livoti, Jr. individually and Anthony Livoti, Jr. P.A., solely in their capacity as trustee (collectively, the "Receivership Entities"), hereby moves this Court for authority to enter into the attached settlement agreements (and other settlement agreements) to resolve the Receiver's claims against certain of MBC's former sales agents in an action currently pending before Judge Graham as *Receiver v. Shao-Feng Wang, et al.*, Case No. 06-60970-Civ-Graham. The Receiver states as grounds:

- 1. On May 4, 2004, this Court entered an Order Appointing Receiver (the "Receivership Order") in this case. The Receivership Order appointed Roberto Martínez, Esq., of the law firm Colson Hicks Eidson, as Receiver.
 - 2. Paragraph 2 of the Receivership Order directs the Receiver to:

Investigate the manner in which the affairs of [the Receivership Entities] were conducted and institute such actions and legal proceedings, for the benefit and on behalf of [the Receivership Entities] and their investors and other creditors, as the Receiver deems necessary . . . against any transfers of monies or other proceeds directly or indirectly traceable from investors in [the Receivership Entities]; provided such actions may include, but not be limited to, . . . disgorgement of profits, recovery and/or avoidance of fraudulent transfers under Florida Statute § 726.101, et seq. or otherwise

- 3. In addition, Paragraph 7 of the Receivership Order provides that the Receiver may "settle legal actions . . . in which MBC, VBLLC and VSI or the Receiver is a party, commenced either prior to or subsequent to this Order, with authorization of this Court."
- 4. The Receiver has filed a Complaint against a number of MBC's former sales agents. The lawsuit brings a single claim for breach of contract against each of the defendants seeking the return of commissions that they were paid on "pre-closing" investor funds that were raised from investors but never actually invested in an insurance policy and have since been returned by order of this Court. Each of the sales agents had a sales representative contract with MBC that required them to return their commissions if the investor's funds were returned to them. A copy of the Complaint is attached as Exhibit A.
- 5. This lawsuit is different from, and much narrower than, a lawsuit previously brought by the Receiver against essentially all of MBC's former sales agents seeking the disgorgement of *all* of the commissions they had received from MBC. That previous lawsuit

was dismissed by this Court for lack of standing by the Receiver. The instant lawsuit, by contrast, deals only with "pre-closing" commissions and is based solely on the contract between MBC and its former sales agents.

- 6. Although this lawsuit was randomly assigned to Judge Graham when it was filed, the Receiver is seeking authorization from this Court to enter into the proposed settlement agreements because the Receivership Order was entered by this Court.
- 7. The Receiver has reached proposed settlements with the following MBC sales agents in the following amounts:

The written Settlement Agreements are attached as Exhibit B.

8. The Receiver submits that these Settlement Agreements are fair and equitable and in the best interests of the Receivership Estate. The MBC sales agents at issue generally received small amounts in commissions as compared to other MBC sales agents, making it more cost-effective to resolve the claim without the cost of further litigation. In addition to having received small amounts, the settling MBC sales agents are individuals or small businesses spread throughout the country, which would give rise to a variety of collection

issues in the event the Receiver obtained a money judgment against them.¹

9. Settlement discussions with other MBC sales agents are ongoing, and the Receiver anticipates reaching similar settlement agreements for additional MBC Sales Agents named in the lawsuit. Because the amounts of the settlements are relatively small, and because there are no unusual terms necessary for any of the settlements other than a payment of an agreed-upon sum, the Receiver is also respectfully requesting authority from the Court to settle the claims against the remaining defendants in this lawsuit without returning to this Court for specific authorization for each settlement in this lawsuit (and in this lawsuit only). This would save time and money and would expedite the process of reaching settlements.

The Receiver is prepared to advise the Court, if requested, of the specific formula applied to determine the dollar amounts in each of these proposed Settlement Agreements. As a lawsuit is still pending against the non-settling MBC sales agents, the Receiver requests permission to provide such additional information, if necessary, to the Court under seal, so as not to divulge strategic considerations to the defendants that remain in the lawsuit.

WHEREFORE, the Receiver respectfully requests that the Court enter the attached proposed Order authorizing the Receiver to enter into the attached proposed Settlement Agreements and authorizing the Receiver to settle the remaining claims in *Receiver v. Shao-Feng Wang, et al.*, Case No. 06-60970-Civ-Graham, without returning for specific authorization from this Court.
