SECOND INTERIM PETITION FOR FEES AND COSTS OF RACHLIN COHEN & HOLTZ, COMPUTER FORENSIC DIVISION, AS COMPUTER CONSULTANTS TO THE RECEIVER AND MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

(June 26, 2004 – September 30, 2004)

Pursuant to Court Order, all objections to this Application must be filed and served within ten (10) days of this Application.

Rachlin Cohen & Holtz (RC&H) hereby requests this Court to enter an order authorizing the Receiver to pay the reasonable computer consultant's fees and costs

incurred by RC&H from June 26, 2004 through September 30, 2004, and in support of this application states

- 1. Attached as **Exhibit 1** is a summary of RC&H fees and expenses. **Exhibit 2** is a summary of all RC&H's timekeepers, their billing rates and the total hours that were charged by each timekeeper in their representation of the Receiver through September 30, 2004 (the "Application Period"). RC&H has agreed to a 10% reduction in its fees for services provided to the Receiver, as reflected in **Exhibit 2**, representing a savings to the receivership of \$862.50.1
- 2. The Receiver retained RC&H to assist in the acquisition, extraction and analysis of data from computer hard drives, servers, workstations, and other media and other related services as required. During this Application Period, RC&H has assisted the Receiver and his counsel in responding to request for production of electronic information from the OIR, as well as assisting the Receiver and his counsel and the forensic accountants in gathering information from the MBC database, and has assisted in the creation of a database containing MBC and VSI data for the purpose of responding to inquiries from investors and agents.
- 4. For the Application Period, RC&H seeks reimbursement for total project fees in the amount of \$7,762.50, which reflects a 10% discount (of \$862.50) and total expenses in the amount of \$0. The services rendered to the Receiver fall under the following categories:

<sup>1</sup> RC&H maintains detailed time records that are kept contemporaneously with the services performed. Receiver's counsel will, within ten days, seek to file these detailed records under seal to the Court for review *in camera* and ex

- a. Requests for Electronic Data RC&H gathered electronic data at MBC in response to requests for production of documents served on the Receiver by the ORI and other regulatory agencies.
- b. <u>Database Export</u> RC&H also assisted in the creation of a database comprised of MBC's investor database and VSI's database in order to allow the Receiver and Claims Administrator to respond to inquiries from investors and agents on the status of policies.
- 5. I have carefully reviewed the attached exhibits and I am responsible for supervising all RC&H personnel on the case. I certify that the hours expended and the costs incurred were necessary and reasonable to provide services to the Receiver during the Application Period. RC&H has discounted its normal rates for the services rendered in matters of this kind.

### MEMORANDUM OF LAW

This Court entered an Order authorizing the Receiver to retain RC&H as computer consultant for the MBC matter. In that Order, this Court found that the RC&H rates described in Exhibit A2 are fair and reasonable. See Order Approving Receiver=s Notice of Intention to Retain Rachlin Cohen & Holtz as Computer Consultant dated June 4, 2004. This Court has the power to award the Receiver fees for his services and for expenses incurred by the Receiver in the performance of his duties. See Donovan v. Robbins, 588 F.Supp. 1268, 1272 (N.D. Ill. 1984). The Receiver has incurred the expense of RC&H (computer consultant) in furtherance of his duties. RC&H has provided services to the Receiver to assist in stabilizing MBC's operations and effectively protecting,

controlling and maintaining MBC and VSI's computerized data. RC&H respectfully submits that it is entitled to be compensated for the services provided to the Receiver.

WHEREFORE, Rachlin Cohen & Holtz, by and through the undersigned, respectfully requests that this Court enter an Order Authorizing the Payment of \$7,762.50 in fees and reimbursement of **\$0** in costs for this Application Period. A proposed form of Order is attached.

# ORDER GRANTING SECOND PETITION FOR FEES AND COSTS OF RACHLIN COHEN & HOLTZ, COMPUTER FORENSIC DIVISION

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on Rachlin Cohen & Holtz's Second Interim Petition for Fees and Costs (the "Petition"). The Court has heard comments by interested parties, carefully reviewed the Petition and case file and is otherwise fully advised in the premises.

THE COURT notes that by prior Order this Court authorized the Receiver to "appoint one or more special agents, employ legal counsel, actuaries, accountants, claims administrators, clerks, consultants and assistants as the Receiver deems necessary and to fix and pay their reasonable compensation and expenses" subject to the approval by this Court at the time the Receiver accounts to the Court for such expenditures and compensation.

Pursuant to that provision, by prior Order the Court approved Receiver's application to employ Rachlin Cohen & Holtz ("RCH") as Receiver's computer consultant in this action. In the instant Petition, RCH seeks to have the Court authorize the Receiver to compensate RCH for services rendered for the period from June 26, 2004 through September 30, 2004. In total, the Petition seeks approval of the payment of \$7,762.50 in fees and \$0 in costs, which reflects a 10% courtesy discount of \$862.50.

Accordingly, after due consideration, it is

ORDERED and ADJUDGED that Rachlin Cohen & Holtz's Second Interim Petition for
ees and Costs is hereby GRANTED and Receiver, Roberto Martínez is hereby authorized to pay
