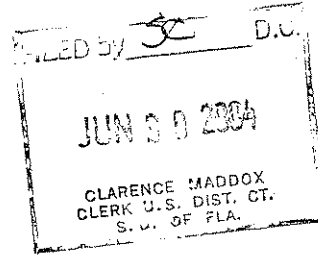

**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S MOTION FOR AUTHORITY
TO PAY PREMIUMS, ADDRESS OTHER OPERATIONAL
ISSUES, AND COMMENCE COLLECTION LITIGATION**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court on Receiver's Motion for Authority to Pay Premiums, Address Other Operational Issues, and Commence Collection Litigation dated June 28, 2004, and the Court have reviewed the Motion, it is hereby

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The Receiver shall have the authority to pay premiums for all policies from the various premium escrow accounts, even those policies the premium payments for which are otherwise payable from the MBC operating funds;
2. The Receiver shall have the authority to make the changes in "beneficiary" requests in order to have current, accurate records of the potential claim holders, but without any inference to be associated with such action;
3. The Receiver shall have the authority to continue to employ employees as needed to perform necessary functions, even though the employees' services are not needed on a regular basis;
4. The Receiver shall have the authority to deposit checks representing payments associated with the ownership or beneficial interest in policies, including death benefits, where such checks are made out to a party other than one of the Receivership Entities;
5. The Receiver shall have the authority to require and direct such payees, including Livoti and UPBNA, to endorse the checks over to the Receiver; and
6. The Receiver shall have the authority to begin asset collection efforts, including the continuation of forensic analysis necessary to pursue potential fraudulent conveyances.
