FIRST INTERIM PETITION FOR FEES AND COSTS TO THE GARDEN CITY GROUP, INC. AS CLAIMS ADMINISTRATOR FOR THE RECEIVER AND MEMORANDUM IN SUPPORT

(May 11, 2004 - June 18, 2004)

Pursuant to Court Order, all objections to this Application must be filed and served within ten (10) days of this Application.

The Garden City Group, Inc. ("GCG") moves this Court to award interim fees and costs incurred by GCG as claims administrator to the Receiver, Roberto Martínez (the "Receiver"), in support of this application, the undersigned submits the following:

- 1. Attached as Exhibit "1" is a summary of GCG fees and expenses. Exhibit "2" is an invoice detailing the claims administration services that GCG has provided to the Receivership and expenses incurred through June 18, 2004 (the "Application Period").
- 2. GCG is one of the country's leading class action and chapter 11 administrators with expertise in noticing, claims processing, balloting and distribution. In addition, GCG provides call center capabilities and has extensive expertise in designing and maintaining web sites.
- 3. To date, GCG has assisted the Receiver with responding to voluminous investor/customer inquiries both via email and telephone. GCG has also provided Spanish translations in both of these areas. GCG has set up an automated phone system with live operators to answer investor/customer questions and has linked its web site email system with MBC's system. GCG is also handling the changes of address requests sent by investors as well as other investor correspondence. Going forward, GCG expects to handle the investor/ creditor database and future mailings, along with any required legal notice programs.
- 4. For the Application Period, GCG seeks reimbursement for total project fees in the amount of \$50,195.54 and total expenses in the amount of \$750.00 for P.O. Box rental. No prior applications for compensation have been filed and no compensation has been paid to GCG. The services rendered to Receiver fall under the following categories and the fees breakdown as follows:

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- a. Administration Fees \$26,526.54 GCG incurred these fees to set up the administration process for the Receiver. The Receiver anticipated receiving voluminous calls, letters and e-mails from the over 20,000 MBC investors in addition to agents and brokers involved in MBC's viatical business. The administration fees include organizing, receipt and review of correspondence and e-mail from MBC investors, brokers and agents and setting up a telephone hotline to receive and return calls to interested parties.
- b. Project Management/Consulting Charges \$23,669.00 GCG met with the Receiver and his counsel to fully understand the scope of the project to design a suitable and appropriate administration process. Based on the consultations with the Receiver and his counsel, GCG designed and implemented an administration process for the MBC matter, including, but not limited to, the management, receipt and response to over 2500 e-mails from investors, which in many cases involved translating e-mails from Spanish to English.
- 5. I have carefully reviewed the attached exhibits and I am responsible for supervising all GCG personnel on the case. I certify that the hours expended and the costs incurred were necessary and reasonable to provide services to the Receiver during the Application Period. GCG has charged its normal rates for the services rendered in matters of this kind. GCG rates charged in this matter are described in Exhibit "3" attached hereto.

MEMORANDUM OF LAW

This Court entered an Order authorizing the Receiver to retain GCG as claims administrator

for the MBC matter. In that Order, this Court found that the GCG rates described in Exhibit "B" are

fair and reasonable. See Order Approving Receiver's Notice of Intention to Retain The Garden City

Group as Claims Administrators dated June 3, 2004. This Court has the power to award the

Receiver fees for his services and for expenses incurred by the Receiver in performance of his duties.

See Donovan v. Robbins, 588 F.Supp. 1268, 1272 (N.D. Ill. 1984). The Receiver has incurred

GCG's claims administration expenses in furtherance of his duties. GCG has provided services to

the Receiver to assist in stabilizing MBC's operations and effectively managing the communications

with the large number of MBC's investors and setting up a process the deal with investor claims in

the future. GCG respectfully submits that it is entitled to compensation for its services.

WHEREFORE, The Garden City Group, Inc., by and through the undersigned, respectfully

requests that this Court enter an Order Authorizing the Payment of \$50,195.54 in fees and

reimbursement of \$750.00 in costs for the Application Period. A proposed form of Order is

attached.
