IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a Presentence Investigation and Report to this Court will be completed. DEFENSE COUNSEL ARE TO REPORT THIS DATE TO THE UNITED STATES PROBATION OFFICE OF THE COURT FOR INTERVIEW AND FURTHER INSTRUCTION. IF ON BOND, THE DEFENDANT SHALL REPORT TO THE PROBATION OFFICE ALSO.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the U.S. Attorney's Office immediately provide the U.S. Probation Department with the necessary information to prepare the Prosecution of the Presentence Report.
