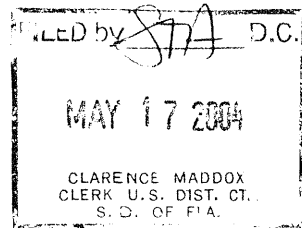

**ORDER GRANTING AGREED MOTION FOR A TWO-WEEK CONTINUANCE
OF PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION HEARING AND CORRESPONDING
EXTENSION OF TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND OTHER
EMERGENCY RELIEF**

THIS CAUSE comes before the Court upon an Agreed Motion filed by Plaintiff Securities and Exchange Commission ("SEC" or "Commission"), Defendant Mutual Benefits Corporation and Relief Defendants Viatical Benefactors, LLC and Viatical Services, Inc., by and through their court-appointed Receiver, Roberto Martinez ("Receiver"), Defendants Joel Steinger, Leslie Steinger and Peter Lombardi (collectively, "the individual Defendants") and Relief Defendants Kensington Management, Inc., Rainy Consulting Corp., Twin Groves Investments, Inc., P.J.L. Consulting Inc., SKS Consulting, Inc., and Camden Consulting, Inc., by

and through their undersigned counsel, for the entry of an Order continuing the Preliminary Injunction hearing currently scheduled for May 17, 2004 at 2:00 p.m., and extending the Court's May 4, 2004 Temporary Restraining Order and Other Emergency Relief ("TRO Order") through the conclusion of the Preliminary Injunction hearing and issuance of an Order by this Court. Upon consideration of the Agreed Motion, the Court finds that the parties have shown good cause for a continuance of the show cause hearing and corresponding extension of the TRO Order in order to preserve the temporary injunction and asset freeze. The individual Defendants have in fact requested the continuance to a date no earlier than June 3, 2004, and agreed to the extension of the TRO Order in accordance with Rule 65(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and the Court being otherwise fully advised in the premises, accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

The Agreed Motion is GRANTED. The Show Cause hearing is continued to June 10, 2004, at 9:00 ~~a.m./p.m.~~; the Court's May 4, 2004 TRO Order shall be extended until conclusion and the Court's resolution of the Preliminary Injunction hearing, or until further Order of this Court.
