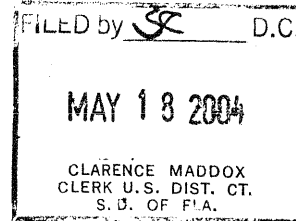

**ORDER SETTING EVIDENTIARY HEARING, EXTENDING THE TEMPORARY
RESTRAINING ORDER AND SETTING BRIEFING SCHEDULE**

THIS CAUSE came before the Court upon a *sua sponte* review of the record . It is

ADJUDGED that an EVIDENTIARY HEARING shall take place before the undersigned,
United States District Judge Federico A. Moreno, at the United States Courthouse, Courtroom IV,
Tenth Floor, Federal Justice Building, 99 Northeast 4th Street, Miami, Florida 33132, on **Thursday**
and Friday, June 10-11, 2004, beginning at 9:00 A.M. Counsel shall be prepared to address all
pending matters that the Court has not referred to a magistrate. Further, it is

ADJUDGED that the Court's Temporary Restraining Order (**D.E. No. 25**), filed on **May 4,**
2004, is EXTENDED until the end of the evidentiary hearing. Finally, it is

ADJUDGED that the parties shall comply with the following briefing schedule:

1. **Jurisdictional Issue** - As to the threshold jurisdictional issue of whether the policies in this action constitute a security, the parties shall file their pleadings no later than **Jun 3, 2004**.
2. **Representation of MBC** - As to Mr. Hogan's continued representation of Mutual Benefits Corporation in view of the appointment of a receiver, Mr. Hogan shall file his pleading no later than **May 19, 2004**. In response, the SEC shall file its response no later than **May 21, 2004**.
3. **Witness and Exhibit Lists** - As to the evidentiary hearing, the parties shall submit numbered witness and exhibit lists that include a paragraph explanation of the exhibit or the substance of the testimony. The SEC shall submit its witness and exhibit lists no later than **May 27, 2004**. Any Defendant wishing to introduce exhibits or call witnesses at the evidentiary hearing must file its witness and exhibit list no later than **June 3, 2004**.
